COMPETITION RULES

Both competitions will be conducted under the IOF 2014 Competition Rules and the FISO Federal Technical Rules. The Sprint map has been created according to the ISSOM specifications and the Middle map according to the ISOM specifications.

Thursday 24 of April from 10.00 AM; the controls will be picked up on Friday 25th at 07:00 PM.

Model event start: Cadine park (GPS 46.087579, 11.064996)

Map: Cadine, scale 1:4.000, contour interval 5 meters, updates on 2014 by Stefano Raus

Type: free course

The Model event terrain is similar to what will be found in the Sprint competition.

START LOCATIONS

Sprint: 5 minutes from the meeting area

Middle: 35 minutes from the meeting area

RACE TERRAIN

Sprint: the race terrain is made up of two different parts. There are both a landed country zone with small wooded areas and an urban zone, with narrow streets, parks and gardens. There are a lot of clearly recognized private areas.

Middle: forest with quite different areas. The first part presents an excellent visibility, soft terrain and high speed running; the second part is highly detailed and technic, with low visibility, hard and rough terrain, very low speed running.

TRACKS CHARACTERISTICS

Sprint: the tracks will be very short, therefore a fast map reading and the ability to keep rapid decisions will have a high value, as well as the skill to find the best way choices for a sprint race.

Middle: this will be a typical middle race, with many direction changes, for which an accurate and precise map reading and numerous pace changing will be necessary.

EMBARGOED AREA

As written in the article 5.7 of the Federal Technic Rules, the area highlighted in the web page campionatiaprile2014.it/zone-embargate.html is embargoed and, as such, it's forbidden for all orienteers, except for the members of the organizing committee and the staff, who will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

PARKINGS

Parking areas will be set up both on Saturday and Sunday near the meeting point. The way to reach the meeting area from the parking will be marked with tapes and it will be not allowed to leave that path. A special parking for campers will be arranged at about 1,2km from the meeting point.

TAPING

For the Italian Middle Championships, it is recommended the use of the taping, due to the mainly rough, steep and stony terrain.

CLOTHES SERVICE

For the Italian Middle Championships, at the start zone it will be possible to leave clothes, that will be brought to the finish area as soon as possible. It is recommended to leave the clothes in recognizable bags, but some plastic bags and markers will be available at the gathering area.

MAPS COLLECTION

At the end of the race, every runner must deliver the map to the staff. The maps will be returned in team bags at the end of the competition.

TEAM TENTS

A special zone for the team tents will be available next to the finish area. The kindergarten will be set up in the same area by the organizing committee.

PRIZE GIVING

Sprint: the prize giving will be at 2:30 PM of Saturday 26th of April, at the Sopramonte Sport Center.

Middle: the prize giving will be at 2:30 PM of Sunday 27th of April, at the Sopramonte Sport Center.

ENTRIES

Italian teams will add the entries of its agonist athletes through the FISO web site.

The entries will be closed at 12:59 PM of Monday 21st of April 2014.

The entries of the Beginners and Direct will be possible at the race office.

The cost of the entry in the categories Beginners, Direct, M/W12, M/W14, M/W16 is 5,00€

The cost of the entry in all other categories is 10,00€
