

AREA

Saturday: by car, exit A1 VAR ("direttissima") motorway at BADIA junction (6 km to the arena).

Sunday: by car, exit A1 ("panoramica") motorway at PIAN DEL VOGLIO junction (5 km to the arena). From the highway to the arena follow the arrows, not navigator!

PUNCHING SYSTEM

Sport Ident system will be used for all classes. Air+ touch free system won't be activated.

BIBS

All competitors, except Elite, will use the same bib number for both competitions. Elite runners will have one bib for each race; sprint's bibs will be distributed into the quarantine, middle's bibs will be available on the pre-start.

PRIZE GIVING CERIMONY

Best six Elites, the first of DIRECT, A, B (only Sunday) and C, and best three runners of other classes will be awarded.

SUSTAINABILITY

The event is supported by UISP and Regione Emilia-Romagna in the context of the project "Primo è l'ambiente" (Environment first).

To raise awareness about waste reduction, each competitor will receive a reusable plastic glass to be used at the refreshments and at the bar.

Recycling bins will be available at the arena, please use them correctly.

ARENA

Castiglione dei Pepoli

Piscina Val di Sole, via del Loghetto 4 Coordinate: 44.144619, 11.158500

Access to toilets, showers and dressing rooms. Club tents are welcome.

Kindergarten is available at the arena.

Bar service, run by Pro Loco of Castiglione dei Pepoli, will be prepared at the arena.



PARKING

You can drive to the parking only by using the following roads: via Bolognese, via Aldo Moro, via Dante Alighieri, via U. Nobili (like shown on the map). If you arrive after 14:00 you'll need to print a pass. You can print the pass in the <u>download area</u> on FISO website.

Dedicated parking areas will be available, please follow the stewards' instructions. Parking area to arena: 400 m maximum.

Some packing spots will be inside the quarantine area, access to these cars is forbidden between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m.







EMBARGOED AREA

The entire area of Castiglione dei Pepoli is embargoed. Access to the embargoed area before the competition, as well as return to the competition area before the end of the event, is strictly forbidden.

MAP

Castiglione dei Pepoli – scale 1:4000 – contours interval 2,5 m -Production 2019.

A4 format; the map is printed on water resistant pretex paper. Plastic bags are available at the start.





TERRAIN

Urban terrain between 650 and 700 metres above sea level featuring some small parks. Courses will mostly be on asphalt with several steep slopes and steps.

Asphalt 80-95%, park 20-5 %, suggested running shoes or orienteering shoes without spikes.

Race area in partially closed to traffic, be careful when crossing road and oncoming cars.

QUARANTINE

For M/W Elite classes there will be a quarantine area, entrance time limit at 2.55 p.m. Please do not use electronic devices.

Arena to quarantine: 300 m.

GPS

START

Distance from arena to prestart: 300m. It's possible to warm up only on the way from the arena to the start and in the areas shown in the arena scheme.

Prestart will be at -4.

Control descriptions are in the start corridor and on the map, maximum size 13,8 x 4,8 cm.

The start is delayed start, point K is 20 m from the pick-up map's place.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

BARRIERS

There will be barriers in the city centre in order to ensure traffic restriction. Traffic wardens will guard the majority of them. These barriers won't be marked on maps and can be crossed by athletes during the competition.

MARKED AREAS


Small construction sites and forbidden areas can be found in the competition area. Forbidden areas are marked on maps with the designated magenta symbol and will be taped off with "Masi tape" (see below) if on possible route choices. In addition, remarkably dangerous walls, mapped as impassable walls, will be taped off.



SPIRAL STAIRCASE

In the competition area there is a spiral staircase with exits on three different levels.







CLOTHES RACKS

Within the running arena there will be clothes racks marked on maps with the power line symbol.





PROMINENT MAN-MADE FEATURES

Control no. 100 is positioned on a Masi flag, marked on maps as a prominent man-made feature.

TIME LIMIT

Maximum time limit to complete the course is 1 hour.


From the highway to the arena follow the arrows, not navigator!

Kindergarten will be available at the arena.



PARKING

Please follow the stewards' instructions. Parking area to arena: 700 m maximum.

Free campervan overnight parking will be possible by Chalet Valserena.

During the event days cars will be allowed only on SP79 road.



A4 format; the map is printed on water resistant pretex paper. Plastic bags are available at the start.





TERRAIN

Broadleaf woodland between 900 and 1100 metres above sea level with several valleys and good visibility. The terrain includes some very detailed areas with poor visibility. Good to excellent runnability depending on the steepness and vegetation. There are private houses in the woodland.

Suggested orienteering shoes with spikes.

START

Distance of pre-start from the arena: 1000 m + 125 (25' walking).

Along the taped path to the pre-start, warm-up maps with a couple of controls will be available to be taken.

Garments left in pre-start will be brought back to the arena.

Prestart will be at -4.

Control descriptions are in the start corridor and on the map, maximum size 20 x 4,8 cm.

The start marked on maps corresponds to the pick-up map's place.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

In the forest there are some areas with a massive presence of fallen trees, those areas are marked with the undergrowth symbol.

Roots are marked with a green X only if isolated and/or prominent.

There will be several private areas surrounding houses. Not all of them are fenced. We remind not to cross them anyway.

From the second to last control to control no. 100, all the classes will have to pass through a crossing point in order to get to the other side of the paved road. The crossing point will be guarded, but great caution is still recommended. From the crossing point to control no. 100 there is a compulsory path to follow, delimitated by cones. Since this path will cross the arena, we ask everyone to be careful not to hinder running athletes.

Maximum time limit to complete the course is 2 hours.


