We are excited to welcome you to the fifth edition of this spectacular orienteering relay! The competition has a unique and thrilling race formula based on club spirit.

Venue

The competition venue is the pine and spruce forest at 1100-1300m above sea level around Collepietra just some kilometres from Bolzano. The Arena is the same for both competition days.

Program

- Friday, 29th May 2020, afternoon - training
- Saturday, 30th May 2020, afternoon – Italian Cup, Middle - Collepietra, GPS 46.464536, 11.457583
- Sunday 31st May 2020, morning - Relay of the Dolomites, Collepietra, GPS 46.464536, 11.457583

Italian Cup

The day before the Relay, Saturday 30th May, our friends from Sport Club Meran organize the Italian Cup, Middle distance – more info on: <https://www.fiso.it/gara/202011>. Entries for Italian runners shall be made through www.fiso.it, while foreign runners must enter via e-mail: orientierungslauf@sportclub-meran.it, specifying name, surname, class, club, nation, SI-chip number and date of birth.

Entries for the race close one week before the event. Entries for classes ESO and Direct are possible at the venue.

*the recommended age for 2nd and 3^d leg is 14 years and older

Runners from different clubs are allowed to run together but as it is a club relay it is strongly recommended to compose club teams!

Kids Relay

There will be two classes: Boys and Girls. The age is 10-14 years old (born 2006-2010). Each team consists of two athletes. The girls can run in the boys' class. It is strongly recommended to compose club teams!

Terrain

Coniferous forest at 1100-1300m above sea level. Runnability and visibility mostly good. Hilly topography with moderate to steeper slopes with a dense net of forest roads and hiking trails. There are some cultivated fields, rock details and many contour features.

Map

The existing map from year 1994 is completely renewed. Scale 1:10.000, 5m for Relay of the Dolomites and 1:7.500, 5m for Kids Relay. The map is produced in December 2019 by the mapmakers Viktor Kirianov, Vadym Prokopchuk, Mykhaylo Teslenko and Oleksandr Yefimenko.

GPS live tracking

Live tracking will be used. On the 1st, 4th and 5th legs the 10 best teams will be asked to wear vests with a GPS unit.

Prize-giving

The first 10 teams will be awarded value prizes. There will be also a prize-giving ceremony for the first three teams in both categories of Kids Relay.

Entry

The entry is open from February 1, 2020 on our website: www.relay-dolomites.com

Entry fee:

- 75,00 Euro for Relay of the Dolomites and 10,00€ for Kids Relay for entries within 10th May 2020 (date within which the entry fee has to be sent, no names required)

- 100,00 Euro for Relay of the Dolomites and 12,00€ for Kids Relay for entries within 24th May 2020 (date within which the entry fee has to be sent, no names required)

The deadline for the final entry with the athletes' names is Tuesday 26th May!

Runners bank

If you have difficulties to combine your own team you can contact the organisers and ask for help via e-mail: relay-dolomites@tolweb.net. Please provide the following data: name, surname, date of birth, gender, nation, SI-Card, e-mail, phone number, preferred leg. It will also be possible to start as a single runner with the last restart. The entry fee is 15,00 Euro. Please use the Entry Form from www.relay-dolomites.com

Individual runners without team have the possibility to run one of two prepared courses reserved for single athletes.
