# **COMPETITION CENTER**

From 13:00 in the <u>Cittadella dell Sport (Google Maps)</u>, in Piazzale Azzurri d'Italia 1. Parking is permitted near the Arena and it's free of charge.

The Competition Center will open at 13:15 and it will be in the gym. Participants are permitted to use the toilets of the restaurant.

# **CATEGORIES & ENTRIES**

There will be 4 categories, which will be different in order of difficulty, with the following indicative lengths:

- Bianco&Groups 1,5km
- ► Giallo 2,4km
- Rosso 3,3km
- ► **Nero** 4,2km

Entries are open from 7/2/2023 to 23:59 of Wednesday 22/2/2023. The cost is €5 for each Participant, without category distinctions. Entries can be made following these links:

- OrienteeringOnline webpage, for foreigners Clubs and Athletes

Entries will also be accepted **the day of the competition**, in the Competition Center, until maps are exhausted. Competition-day entries can be made **until 14:00**.

A €3 Day Card will be available for non registered Runners. The Day Card will cover the insurance for the day of the Competition only and will permit the registration, after a signed module, as requested by the Day Card Regulation (ITA).







#### **PAYMENT**

Payments must be made by **bank transfer**, one for every Club if possible, with "Comitato Regionale FISO FVG" as beneficiary - IBAN **IT56 F054 8464 890C C070 0421 02** - sending a copy of the payment before Thursday 23/2/2023 to the email <a href="mailto:comitato@fisofvg.it">comitato@fisofvg.it</a>. Please write "**Iscrizione Yor23 del 25/2/2023**" as the reason of the transfer.

# MAP & TERRAIN

Grado, scale 1:5000, eq. 2,5m, realised in 2015, adjourned in August 2020. Maps will be printer on blue-back paper. The terrain will be a typical city terrain, with paved roads, parks, sand beaches and some canals.

# **START**

The distance between the Competition Center and the Start is about **1,8km**; going to the Start Competitors will have to follow the indications, without taking alternative routes. Remember to take in consideration the time taken to transfer to the Start.

The first start will be at 15:00 and will follow a start list, with one start every two minutes for all categories.

Late starters will use the "punching-start" to start their race, considering the original start time. The race time of each Competitor starts with their starting minute.

For the "Nero", "Rosso" and "Giallo" categories there will be a control description, available at minute -3. For the "Bianco&Groups" category it will be textual, on the map only.

Athletes will not be called to enter the starting gates, it will be everyone's responsibility to show up at the right time. The Start Managers will not take the control descriptions or the race maps and give them to the Competitors; if required, they can check whether the category on the map is correct, but it is still a competitor's responsibility to make sure of this during the Race.







#### **FINISH**

The Finish will be located **about 1.3km from the Competition Center**; after punching the Finish Control, the Competitors can return to the meeting point following the white-red tapes. The maps will not be collected at the end of the Competition, we trust in everyone's Fair Play.

# AWARD CEREMONY

The Award Ceremony will be approximately at 17:00. The **first three men** and the **first three women** of all categories will be awarded, excluding Groups, who will not have a ranking.

#### **PUNCHING SYSTEM**

All controls will be equipped with cips that support **AIR+ technology**, so it will be possible to use **SIAC** type Si-Card.

For those who will **rent the SI-Card**, they can request one at the Competition Center (not the SIAC type) **for €2 each**. All the rented SI-Cards must be returned at the Competition Center after the Race; in case of loss, the Organization will have to be compensated for 30€.

Please note that in the event of control or SI-Card failure, there will be manual punches on all controls and back-up boxes on the maps.

#### RACE WITHDRAWAL

In case of withdrawal from the Race, it is mandatory for each Competitor to notify the Organization of the abandonment of the Competition.

### OTHER INFORMATION

It is allowed to compete with the "shadow", with someone that follows a young Competitor, but the people that follow must have already completed their Race or not participate. We ask to stay within the limit of Fair Play. It may be convenient for the Organization to know the number of these Competitors at the time of the registration. The "shadow" is allowed for the "Bianco" category only.







**City traffic will circulate regularly**, without interruptions to ease the Race. The Organization reminds you to respect the Traffic Laws and invites the Competitors to **pay attention** to the vehicles and the other people present on the terrain.

There will be a **refreshment point** at the end of the Race, near the "Le Piramidi" restaurant, at the Competition Center, where you can drink and eat what will be made available by the restaurant.

Unless otherwise specified in this Bulletin, reference is made to the <u>2023 CO</u> <u>Regulation</u>.

# RESPONSABILITY

Each Competitor runs under his own responsibility, the Organization declines all responsibility for damage to things or people that occurred before, during and after the Event. By registering, the Athletes declare, under their own responsibility, that they are fit and suitable for the sporting activity covered by the Event, in accordance with current Health Laws.
