Many rocky/ground features and micro-details. All the old map is embargoed (see Eventor or last event on the map in 2019)

Results and prizes	Results will be published on the website and live on www.bostek.it/live after last start Prize giving will be held on Sunday at 13.30, after the competition, for the first three OPEN ELITE and PH.CH. and the first DIRECT of both stages (no combined results of the two stages). Following, prize giving for Italian Temp-O champs (first three), Lazio's Pre-O champs (first) and Italian Cup final standings in Open/PhCh. (first three)

Saturday 28th october – WRE TEMP-O event (Italian champs)	
Event centre	Parking area “Campo della Fiera” GPS 42.000830, 12.093207 It's an outdoor event center, with possibility to leave small bags at the registration tent Accessible mobile toilet available. Water available at the registration tent.
Transport	Once you get to Cerveteri, just follow via della Necropoli for 600m to reach the parking
Start times	First start at 14.00 close to the event centre
Time keeping	Marshals use ANT
Courses and maps	OPEN ELITE / PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED: 7 stations with 5 tasks each (with Zero answer) DIRECT / BEGINNERS: 4 stations with 5 tasks each (with Zero answer) A sample time station is available near the event centre Maps are made with TOM (A5 size) and will be laminated: only LOOSE copy available

Sunday 29th october – WRE PRE-O event (Lazio's regional champs)	
Event centre	Main parking area of the Etruscan necropolis GPS 42.005808, 12.101731 It's an outdoor event center, with possibility to leave small bags at the registration tent Accessible mobile toilet available. Water available at the registration tent.
Transport	Once you get to Cerveteri, just follow via della Necropoli for 1500m to reach the parking
Start times	First start at 10:00 , 50m from to the event centre, past the sample time station
Courses and maps	OPEN ELITE / PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED: 26 tasks + 2 time controls (3 tasks each, no Zero) DIRECT / BEGINNERS: 18 tasks + 1 time control (3 tasks, no Zero) A sample time station is available near the event centre (3 tasks, no Zero): it's “urban” and not relevant for the competition (more for beginners to try a time control and for OpenElite/Ph.Ch. to switch from Temp-O to 3 tasks no Zero) Maps are printed in A5 size on pretex paper (water-resistant) Control circles are split into two copies of the map to avoid overlapping and improve readability Time station maps are made with TOM (A5 size) and will be laminated: only LOOSE copy available
Punching system and time keeping	Punching on paper control card with personal puncher (please bring your own). Time-keeping with sportident (bring your own sicard and make sure it's the same in Eventor) Time stations: marshals use ANT

General information about Saturday 28th october Foot-O training	
Location	Macchia della Signora parking area – GPS 41.984945, 12.117501 Distance from TempO event centre: 3,5km – 6min by car There's no toilet in the area. Please bring your own water, few bottles will be available.
Start times	Start will stay open from 12:00 till 17:00 At 18:00 controls will be collected, no exceptions!
Courses	Course planner: Stefano Zarfati WHITE short easy winning time 15-20' RED medium winning time 20-25' BLACK long difficult winning time 25-30'
Map and terrain	Medium-low visibility and runnability of the forest, dense network of paths, though some might be covered in leaves. Some areas with lots of pits/caves and steep slopes. Map from 2019 event: https://doma.asdorsamaggiore.it/map_images/18.jpg
Punching and timing	Sport-Ident with Air+ system activated, split times will be printed.

General information about Photo-Orienteeing	
Location	Cerveteri city centre (600m away from TempO on saturday, 1500m from PreO on sunday) Maps can be requested at the registration desk
Courses	You have to match 22 control circles on the map with the pictures on the back of the map. Solutions will be published on the website on Sunday evening.
Map and terrain	Scale 1:1.500, contours aren't mapped The whole course is in Cerveteri's city centre and the course is 100% accessible.
