

Bulletin TempO 1^ Italian Cup – CHIS Cup Saturday 22 March 2025, Malo

COMPETITION CENTER: Via Deledda 18, Malo. GPS 45.66522084112683, 11.393411965080224

MAP: Montecio di Malo, enlargement in scale 1:3000 of a map ISSprOM 2019 1:4000 contour interval 2.5m, last updated in March 2025.

FORMULA: TempO. 6 stations, each one with 5 tasks and 6 flags. **Z (Zero) answer is possible,** when no flag is in the right position.

CLASSES: Open, Direct, Beginners (same course).

ZERO TOLERANCE The zero tolerance is 4m, no other conditions. This means that in case of a Zero flag, the flags are apart more than 4m from the correct position.

LAYOUT The maps are only in version "loose" and laminated. Each competitor will take care about checking the order when he receive the map bunch at the station.

MODEL Two model stations are available close to the CC.

FIRST START – at 14:00 close to CC. Start order following the start list published and hung at the event center.

BIB NUMBER: The bib numbers on Saturday are valid also for the competition on Sunday. **It is mandatory to wear the bib number.**

COMPETITION PATH Length 2.5km, included the return. Each competitor will receive a control card as a feedback if he/she want to record his/her answers. In the rear there is a map with the path to follow. Some signposts are shown along the path. Follow the directions of the officials.

PROCEDURE In every station the competitor will find a bunch of 5 loose maps on the chair. The competitor can request to give the answers pointing at the letters. The official will declaim the formula "6 flags, ALPHA – BRAVO – CHARLIE - DELTA - ECHO - FOXTROT— Time starts now!". Only at this moment the competitor can open the bunch and solve the first question and the followings. Is is not possible to go to the next map before answering the previous, or go back to the previous map. Time limit for every station is **150 seconds**. 20sec before the term the official will warn the competitor saying "20 seconds!".

ANSWERS The answers must be given clearly using the english phonetic alphabet (**A**lpha, **B**ravo, **C**harlie, **D**elta, **E**cho, **F**oxtrot, **Z**ero). The answers and the overall time are recorded with ANT system. The competitor can record his/her answers if he/she wishes. After completing a station, the competitor goes on along the path till the next STOP sign, and wait the call to the next station.

FINISH From the last station the competitors will come back to the CC following the map. A crossing of a street is present, pay attention.

PRIZEGIVING on Sunday at the end of PreO competition, about at 14:30. Prizes for the first three Open, Paralympic, Direct, and for the first Junior.
