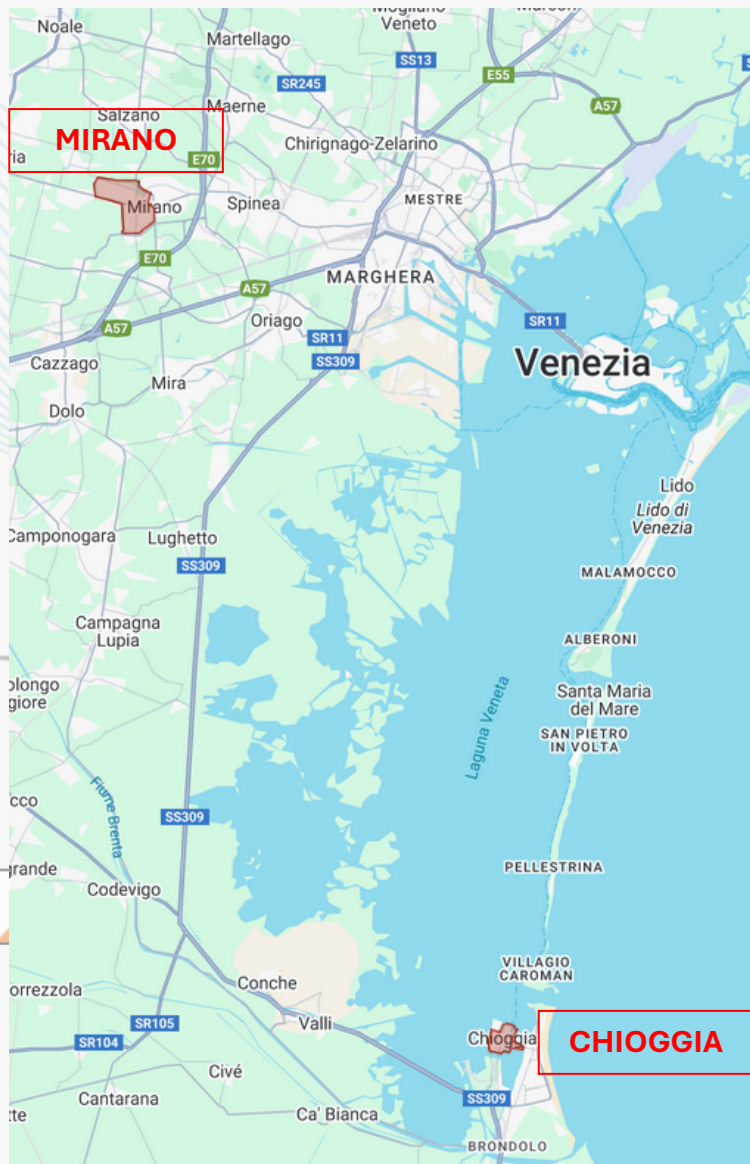

RACES DESCRIPTION

Saturday, 18th October: Italian “Sprint” Championship (winner's time around 12-15 minutes).

Sunday, 19th October: Italian “Sprint Relay” Championship (Elite’s winning team time around 55-60 minutes, other categories around 40-50 minutes).

RACES TERRAIN AND WEATHER CONDITIONS

Chioggia is a historic town with many Venetian influences, characterized by historical and residential buildings sometimes quite tall. The road network consists of main avenues intersected orthogonally by multiple parallel streets, often connected by small passageways. Typical bridges and the scent of the sea are permanently present.

Mirano, on the other hand, is a city with a large central historic square, from which a modern urban environment develops on a flat area. Houses and buildings are interspersed with many well-maintained parks and large, lush green spaces, including hills and unpaved paths.

In the area, weather conditions are pleasant: in October, temperatures expected range is generally from 14°C to 19°C.

Sunrise is at 07.32 and sunset at 18.18. Rainfall situation of the period: approximately 153 mm over 8 days, with occasional winds up to 15 km/h.

REGISTRATION

The registration deadline is set for 11:59 PM on Monday, 13th October 2025. For all Italian members, registration must be occur exclusively on FISO website.

For foreign athletes, registration must be sent via email to galilei.iscrizioni@gmail.com.

For Elite categories (WRE event), remember to register also via IOF Eventor.

For NON FISO MEMBERS, registration for “BIANCO”, “DIRECT”, “ESORDIENTI” categories must occur via email to galilei.iscrizioni@gmail.com by Monday, 13th October 2025. Alternatively, registration may be request during the event days, before the start of the races, until maps are sold out.

For non-members participants, daily membership is available: Day Card “Ludico motoria” for ESORDIENTI or “Non Agonistica” for BIANCO and DIRECT, costs €2. For the “Non Agonistica” Day Card, a medical certificate for non-competitive sports activity (family doctor or pediatrician) is required.

The organization, at its discretion, may accept late registrations for competitive athletes with a 50% surcharge on the registration fee.

Athletes from non-Schengen area countries should check whether a VISA is required to enter Italy.

Competitive three competitors relay categories, one woman required in the first leg (except in OPEN): MW13, MW17, MW20, MW35, MW50, MW195*, OPEN

Competitive four competitors relay categories, with at least two women, one woman required in the first and last leg: MWELite

* The average age of the three participants is greater than or equal to 65 years. The minimum age is 60 years (born in 1965). Examples: $60+65+70 \geq 195$; $60+60+75 \geq 195$; $62+63+70 \geq 195$; $64+65+66 \geq 195$

Changes on the morning of Sunday, 19th October will be allowed until 8:30 AM only for serious and valid verifiable reasons.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

The Sport-Ident punching system will be used for all categories; the Air+ (touch-free) method will be activated.

FINISH FOR THE LAST SPRINT REALY ATHLETE

Only in the event of a simultaneous sprint finish will the finish line judge verify which competitor crossed the finish line first. A camera will be positioned for this purpose.

The position will therefore be determined by the crossing of the finish line and not by the time recorded on the SiCard.

BIB NUMBERS

Competitors will receive a bib number valid for both competitions, which must be worn visible without folds.

GPS

For Saturday's race, the list of 20 ELITE competitors (10 women and 10 men) who will wear GPS will be announced in a special press release. They will be distributed at the start and returned at the finish.

For Sunday's race, the list of 5 ELITE relay teams who will wear GPS will be announced in a special press release. They will be distributed at the start and returned at the finish.

If you have your own GPS vest, you are welcome to bring it with you if you prefer. The vests provided will be collected on Sunday.

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

For each race, the top 3 athletes in the competitive categories and the top 3 relay teams will be awarded.

Please note that there may be discount vouchers included in the prizes.

All under-10 participants will also receive a participation prize.

There will be no awards for the categories Direct, Bianco, Esordienti, or the Open relay.

POST-RACE REFRESHMENTS

Refreshments will be available after each race. To minimize waste, participants are kindly asked to use only one cup, preferable to bring personal cups or bottles.

LIVELOX

At the end of the competitions, the maps of the courses will be available on Livelox, and it will be possible to add your own GPS tracks.

Remember not to publish tracks on Strava or similar social media platform before the end of the current competition, under penalty of disqualification.

PARKING

Parking for Saturday 18th October in Chioggia:

Park 'Saloni'. Distance from the meeting point approx. 500m.

Giove car park. Distance from the meeting point approx. 600m.

Park Lusenzo and surrounding area, also for camper van (equipped parking area) and coaches.

Distance from the meeting point approximately 1400m.

In Sottomarina, Campo Cannoni. Distance from the meeting point approximately 1500m.

Other parking in Sottomarina.

Under specific request of the Municipal Administration, please avoid the Isola dell'Unione car park, which is largely reserved for residents due to ongoing works in the historic centre.

To reach the meeting point, it is necessary to follow the directions that will be included in Bulletin 3, using the map provided, under penalty of disqualification.

It will be necessary to reach the meeting point by 2 p.m.

Parking for Sunday 19th October in Mirano:

Near the municipal stadium in Mirano, also for camper van and coaches.

To reach the meeting point, you must follow the directions provided in Bulletin 3, using the map provided, or you will be disqualified. Distance approximately 1300m.

Additional parking spaces closer to the meeting point will be included in Bulletin 3.

You must arrive at the meeting point by 9:30 a.m.

GENERAL RULES AND ANTI-DOPING

ANTI-DOPING

Doping is prohibited. The organizers of the 2 Giorni della Serenissima 2025 event are committed to supporting the anti-doping authorities in their work. The IOF anti-doping rules (January 1, 2021) and the 2021 World Anti-Doping Code will be applied. Anti-doping controls may be conducted at any time during the competitions in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA

International Standard for Testing and Investigations. Athletes selected for anti-doping testing must bring an official identification (with photo) to the anti-doping testing area. The athlete must present a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), if applicable. It is the responsibility of the competitors to obtain the required TUE certificate (§26.3). Further information can be found on the IOF anti-doping web page.

INSURANCE

The organizers decline any responsibility for issues arising from participation in the events and training sessions of the 2 Giorni della Serenissima 2025. Each participant competes at their own risk and is responsible for their own insurance coverage (illness and injury).
