

Alassio, La Spezia and Spotorno changed from embargoed areas to training maps. Added allowed roads in Pietra Ligure and Albenga. 2026-03-30: Version 7 published. Pietra Ligure and Albenga changed from embargoed areas to training maps after the Gold WRE. The embargoed area in Sestri Levante has been reduced, and the embargo will now remain in place only until May 17th (test race). 2026-04-16: Version 8 published. Embargoed area in Genova reduced. 2026-07-03: Version 9 published. - Embargoed area in Genoa reduced. - Tourist area in Genoa moved to the embargoed area. - Embargoed area in Sestri Ponente reduced. - Model event areas released. - Santa Margherita Ligure released from embargo. - Allowed roads and parking areas highlighted in yellow on the map for specific days.</p>

<p>Other areas info</p>	<p>Embargo rules</p> <p>This embargo applies to all potential WOC 2026 team members and those who intentionally or unintentionally could provide an unfair advantage to competitors at WOC 2026.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access is not allowed within the embargoed areas, marked in red on the map. • It is allowed to use “Permissive routes”, marked in green on the map. • It is allowed to take trains through the embargoed area. Other (public) transport is only allowed along the “Permissive route”. • It is allowed to enter buildings directly from “Permissive routes” (marked in green on the map), as long as that building is directly adjacent to the "Permissive route". It is not allowed to exit the building into an embargoed area. • It is permitted to use the metro through the embargoed area, with surfacing only allowed outside of the embargoed area. • It is permitted to use routes marked in yellow on the map to access the quarantines and the arenas. • No orienteering of any kind may take place in the embargoed areas until after WOC 2026.
